## Description

This 10-hour circular tour departs Porto and heads to the Bairrada region, renowned for its production of distinctive and elegant wines, especially sparkling wines and full-bodied reds made from the Baga grape variety. It's a wine and gastronomy journey that combines tradition, landscape, and flavor, ideal for wine lovers and lovers of regional Portuguese cuisine.

The route follows the A1 toward Anadia, in the heart of Bairrada, with its first stop at the historic Caves São João, founded in 1920. Here, visitors are led through galleries of aging sparkling wines and tasting rooms, where they can taste the house's iconic wines, including crisp whites, aged reds, and classic sparkling wines.

The journey then continues to the charming Quinta da Brejeira, a family-owned property where the Bairrada terroir is celebrated in limited-production wines. The visit provides an up-close look at the artisanal winemaking process, and the tasting is accompanied by local products.

Lunch is served at a typical regional restaurant, with a highlight being the iconic Bairrada roast suckling pig, served with fresh sparkling wine, sliced fries, and salad. The gastronomic experience is one of the highlights of the day.

In the afternoon, there's time to visit the Bairrada Wine Museum in Anadia, which complements the cultural and wine immersion. The return to Porto takes place in the late afternoon, with your senses captivated by the flavors, aromas, and hospitality of Bairrada, a land of excellent wines and memorable cuisine.



**A Quinta das Bégeiras  
Anadia**

Quinta das Bégeiras, located in Fogueira, Anadia, is a reference in Bairrada, known for its artisanal production and deep-rooted tradition. Founded by Mário Sérgio Nuno, the estate maintains a minimalist philosophy: spontaneous fermentations, limited use of wood and unfiltered wines. It stands out for its full-bodied reds made from the Baga grape variety, with great longevity, and for its mineral whites made with Bical and Maria Gomes. The sparkling wines, especially the Brut Natural, reflect freshness and purity. With authentic wines with a strong identity, Quinta das Bégeiras honours the Bairrada terroir with elegance, depth and respect for nature and tradition



**Caves São João  
Sangalhos**

Caves São João, founded in 1920 in Sangalhos, Anadia, is one of the most emblematic names in Bairrada. With a history stretching back centuries, they stand out for producing still wines and classic sparkling wines, renowned for their elegance and longevity. The house is famous for its historic reserves, such as Porta dos Cavaleiros and Frei João, which showcase the evolution of Portuguese wine over the decades. The sparkling wines, produced using the classic method, are fresh and sophisticated. Visits to the cellars allow you to explore a rare wine heritage, with tastings that include old wines, living history and tradition rooted in the heart of Bairrada.

## Wine



The Bairrada region stands out for its remarkable diversity of wines, with a special emphasis on structured reds made from the Baga grape variety and elegant sparkling wines, renowned for their freshness and finesse. Influenced by an Atlantic climate and clay-limestone soils, Bairrada offers unique conditions for wines with vibrant acidity, longevity and character. The combination of winemaking tradition, oenological innovation and respect for the terroir gives the region a striking identity and high-quality wines, valued both in Portugal and internationally.

## Region



The Bairrada Wine Route crosses a landscape of gentle hills, rolling vineyards and picturesque villages between the Atlantic coast and the interior of central Portugal. Rich in historical heritage, it is notable for its monasteries, mansions and cities such as Anadia and Mealhada, which combine tradition and modernity. The gastronomy is memorable, with the famous Bairrada suckling pig, elegant sparkling wines and full-bodied and structured red Baga wines. It is a route that combines nature, culture and intense flavours, providing an authentic sensory experience rooted in the region's identity.
