Palaces Tour Palácio da Brejoeira Monção Ref. 25432

Description

This 10-hour circular tour, departing and arriving in Porto, is ideal for history and architecture lovers, with a focus on visiting the magnificent Brejoeira Palace in Monção. The journey, which begins in the morning, leads through the verdant landscapes of Minho, between vineyards and gentle hills. On the way there, you can stop in Guimarães, home to the Palace of the Dukes of Braganza, a 15th-century palace with Burgundian touches.

Arrival in Monção is scheduled for lunchtime, ideal for savoring the local cuisine. Dishes such as Monção-style roast lamb, accompanied by oven-baked rice, are unmissable specialties, always paired well with the region's famous Alvarinho wine.

In the afternoon, the highlight of the itinerary is a visit to the Brejoeira Palace, a masterpiece of 19th-century neoclassical architecture. Surrounded by 18 hectares of vineyards and romantic gardens, the palace impresses with the elegance of its facade and the refinement of its interiors. Decorated halls, a chapel, a private theater, and period furniture comprise the visit, offering an authentic journey into the lifestyle of the Minho aristocracy. The palace has been classified as a National Monument since 1910.

On the way back to Porto, the tour can include a brief stop in Valença, with its bastioned fortress over the Minho River, or in Ponte de Lima, a historic town with a Roman bridge and one of the oldest centers in Portugal. This route perfectly caps off a day filled with culture, landscape, and tradition, celebrating the monumental heritage of northern Portugal.

The Monção region stands out for its rich monuments and heritage, reflecting centuries of history and devotion. Among its treasures, the Monastery of São Salvador de Ganfei stands out, with Visigothic roots and imposing Romanesque architecture. In Monção, the Convent of the Capuchos reveals the Franciscan legacy, with Baroque features and a serene cloister. These spaces, along with the wine-growing and scenic environment, make Monção a destination for culture, spirituality, and timeless beauty in Alto Minho.
