Day Porto and its Snack Traditions

Morning - Tour of the historic center and visit traditional grocery stores such as A Pérola do Bolhão and Mercearia do Bolhão, famous for their selection of sausages, cheeses and wines, including a visit to the Bolhão Market.

Lunch - Typical restaurant (Ribeira), known for its sausages, cheeses, and regionaldishes.

Afternoon - Visit to a Port wine cellar in Gaia for a guided tasting.

Visit to a regional wine cellar for a tasting of Portuguese cheeses (Serra, Azeitão, São Jorge) with a glass of Port wine.

Accommodation and dinner at the Hotel Palácio doFreixo.







Morning - Travel to Viana do Castelo, with a visit to the Historic Center and a traditional grocery store selling local cheeses and hams.

Next, visit Ponte de Lima, strolling through the historic center, shops selling regional goods, sausages, wine, and cheeses.

Lunch - Regional restaurant in Ponte de Lima, with traditional dishes and convent desserts.

Afternoon - tasting of premium Vinho Verde wines, accompanied by artisanal sausages, at the Adega Cooperativa de Ponte de Lima.

Accommodation and dinner at Carmo's Boutique, with elaborate regional cuisine and a candlelit dinner and tasting of regional wines



Day Mirandela Region Vila Real and Régua


Morning - Departure to Mirandela, the capital of alheira, with a tasting at a local bakeryand grocery store in the historic center.

Continue to Vila Real, visit the Municipal Market, known for its Transmontano cheeses and Bísaro pork sausages.

Lunch: Typical restaurant in Vila Real with regional and traditional foods.

Afternoon - Travel to Régua, visit the Douro Museum and a shop selling regional items.

Lodging at the Hotel Casa da Pacheca, Wine House Hotel, with a wine dinner and regional products, and a Douro wine tasting with cured cheeses and Transmontano ham.







Day Guarda, Viseu and Serra da Estrela

Morning - Travel to Serra da Estrela, visit artisanal cheese factories in Guarda to taste the famous Serra da Estrela DOP cheese.

Tasting of mountain sausages (chorizo, black pudding, and farinheira).

Lunch - Typical mountain meal in a regional restaurant accompanied by local wines.

Afternoon - Continue to Viseu, the heart of the Dão region, with a visit to the Solar do Vinho do Dão.

Tasting of elegant high-altitude wines (Touriga Nacional, Encruzado) with Beira-style ham and regional sausages.

End of the day

Return to Porto.

Playbook – 4-Day Itinerary: Wines, Cheeses, and Sausages of Portugal

Day 1 – Porto: Traditional Flavors and Port Wine

Morning - Stroll through Porto's historic center. Visit traditional grocery stores (A Pérola do Bolhão, Mercearia do Bolhão) and the Bolhão Market.

Lunch - Typical restaurant in Ribeira, specializing in sausages, cheeses, and regional dishes.

Afternoon - Visit to a Port Wine Cellar in Gaia with a guided tasting.

Visit to a regional winery in the historic center to taste Portuguese cheeses (Serra, Azeitão, São Jorge) paired with Port wine.

Dinner & Overnight - Accommodation at the Palácio do Freixo, an icon of Porto on the Douro River.

Day 2 – Viana do Castelo & Ponte de Lima: Vinho Verde and Minho Gastronomy

Morning - Travel to Viana do Castelo: visit the historic center and a traditional cheese and ham grocery store.

Continue to Ponte de Lima: stroll through the historic center and shops selling regional goods.

Lunch - Regional restaurant in Ponte de Lima, serving Minho dishes and convent desserts.

Afternoon - Tasting of premium vinho verde wines accompanied by artisanal sausages at the Ponte de Lima Cooperative Adega.

Dinner & Accommodation at Carmo's Boutique Hotel, with a dinner featuring elaborate regional cuisine, a candlelit experience, paired with Vinho Verde wines.

Day 3 – Mirandela, Vila Real & Régua: Alheira, Transmontano Cheeses, and Douro Wines

Morning - Departure for Mirandela, the capital of alheira, with a tasting at a local bakery and grocery store.

Continue to Vila Real, visit the Municipal Market (Transmontano cheeses and pork sausages).

Lunch - Typical restaurant in Vila Real, featuring regional cuisine.

Afternoon - Travel to Peso da Régua, visit the Douro Museum and a shop selling regional items.

Dinner & Accommodation at Hotel Casa da Pacheca – Wine House Hotel, with a wine dinner featuring regional products, paired with Douro wines, cured cheeses, and Transmontano ham.

Day 4 – Serra da Estrela & Viseu: Serra Cheese and Dão Wines

Morning - Travel to the city of Guarda near Serra da Estrela to visit artisanal cheese factories for a tasting of Serra da Estrela DOP cheese and a tasting of local sausages: chorizo, black pudding, and farinheira.

Lunch - A typical mountain meal at a regional restaurant, accompanied by local wines.

Afternoon - Continue to Viseu, the heart of the Dão region, with a visit to the Solar do Vinho do Dão, where you can taste elegant high-altitude wines (Touriga Nacional, Encruzado) paired with Beirão ham and regional sausages.

Return to Porto.
