Description

This 10-hour circular tour departs from Porto and heads to the heart of the Douro Wine Region, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, on a journey dedicated to wine, landscape, and tradition. The route includes visits to two excellent estates—Quinta do Têdo and Quinta da Pacheca—and passes through emblematic locations such as Régua, Pinhão, and Lamego.

The journey begins on the A4 and IP3 highways, arriving in Peso da Régua, where the journey begins through the wine-growing landscape, marked by terraces and vineyards stretching as far as the eye can see. The first visit is to Quinta do Têdo, located between Régua and Pinhão, in an area where the Têdo River flows into the Douro. Here, visitors can learn about traditional winemaking methods and taste Port and DOC Douro wines in a family-friendly and authentic atmosphere.

Next, we'll travel to Quinta da Pacheca, one of the oldest in the region, known for its architecture, innovation, and superior-quality wines. The visit includes a tour of the wineries, guided tastings, and shopping opportunities.

Lunch is served at one of the estates or at a local restaurant, featuring typical dishes such as Mirandesa steak, cod à lagareiro, or roast kid, always paired with local wines.

In the afternoon, the tour includes a stop in Lamego, where you can visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies or the historic center. The return to Porto is in the late afternoon, concluding a memorable day of wines, landscapes, and Douro tradition.

These cellar visits cost between 20 and 50 € per person and for tasting.



A Quinta da Pacheca Lamego

Quinta da Pacheca, located in Lamego, in the heart of the Douro Demarcated Region, is one of the oldest properties to bottle wines under its own label. With a history dating back to the 18th century, it stands out for both its winemaking tradition and its innovative wine tourism. It produces high-quality DOC Douro wines and Port wines, using grape varieties such as Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz and Tinta Barroca. The wines reveal depth, elegance and a lasting character. The estate offers unique experiences, such as tastings, local cuisine and accommodation in giant barrels, combining tradition, modernity and a stunning landscape over the Douro terraces.



A Quinta do Têdo Pinhão

Quinta do Têdo, located at the confluence of the Douro and Têdo rivers, near Pinhão, is a charming property with roots dating back to the 18th century and a strong vocation for organic viticulture. Certified organic since 2011, it produces DOC Douro wines and Port wines (Ruby, Tawny, LBV, Vintage), with traditional grape varieties such as Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz and Tinta Cão. The wines express elegance, structure and authenticity, reflecting the terroir of Cima Corgo. The estate offers intimate tours, guided tastings and an award-winning restaurant, providing a complete and sophisticated experience in the heart of the Douro.

Wine



The Douro region, one of the oldest and most emblematic wine regions in the world, stands out for its impressive diversity of microclimates, schist soils and native grape varieties, which produce wines that are unique in character and complexity. The combination of centuries-old tradition, terraced viticulture and oenological innovation results in wines of exceptional quality, from elegant reds and whites to iconic Port wines. The Douro reflects the harmony between nature, human know-how and Portuguese winemaking excellence.

Region



The Douro Route, passing through Régua, Lamego and Pinhão, is a stunning route through terraced vineyards and riverbanks, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The landscape is marked by hand-sculpted mountains and deep valleys, where the winemaking tradition has endured for centuries. In addition to the famous Port wines and Douro reds, the region offers a rich gastronomy: roast kid, bôla de Lamego and convent sweets. Baroque churches, shrines and historic farms complete this sensorial experience, where culture, flavour and nature merge in one of Portugal's most emblematic settings.
