Region Galiza Traditional Tapas e Marisco

#### Description

This 10-hour circular tour departs Porto for the charming Galician coastal town of Baiona, Spain, with the main objective of savoring fresh seafood on a route that combines sea, history, and Atlantic landscapes The journey begins by following the A28 toward Viana do Castelo, with a brief stop in this city to explore the Sanctuary of Santa Luzia, with its panoramic views of the Lima estuary and the Atlantic. A visit to the historic center also allows you to appreciate the Manueline architecture, the former Hospital da Misericórdia, and the traditional houses.

From Viana, the route continues along the north coast, passing through Caminha and the mouth of the Minho River, toward the border with Spain. The crossing can be made via Vila Nova de Cerveira and Goián, crossing the bridge over the Minho River, or by taking the river ferry between Caminha and A Guarda (subject to availability and tides). Once in Galician territory, it's worth stopping at Monte de Santa Tecla, near A Guarda, where you'll find archaeological remains of Celtic hillforts and stunning views of the Atlantic.

Arriving in Baiona, the highlights are the marina, the historic center, and the imposing Monterreal fortress, which today houses a hotel but maintains its walled perimeter accessible to the public. Strolling through the town's narrow streets, with their typical shops and welcoming squares, prepares your appetite for the highlight of the visit: a lunch of fresh seafood, such as barnacles, razor clams, shrimp, mussels, and scallops, accompanied by Albariño wine or local craft

After lunch and some free time to enjoy the city beach or terraces, the return journey takes a panoramic route through Tui, with the possibility of visiting its cathedral-fortress. Crossing back into Portugal, the journey concludes peacefully in Porto, after a day rich in Atlantic flavors, culture, and cross-border landscapes.

## Region



The journey from Porto to Vigo and Baiona is a charming crossing of the Iberian northwest, lasting around 2 hours. Leaving the city, you cross the verdant Minho, with vineyards, mountains and the river as company. As you enter Galicia, the landscape transforms into rolling hills and jagged coastline. Vigo offers vibrant culture and typical tapas, while Baiona enchants with its historic port and fresh seafood. The Atlantic coast, with cliffs and coves, accompanies much of the route. On the return to Porto, you will remain with the feeling of a journey rich in flavors, landscapes and shared
