In Dão, a high-altitude granite terroir, Touriga Nacional and Encruzado shine.

The experience is completed with authentic cuisine, from roast kid goat to smoked sausages, and stunning landscapes, where river, mountain, and vineyards intertwine, transforming each moment into an unforgettable memory.









Day Port Wine and its Cellars

In the morning, visit the historic center of Porto and Gaia, and visit a Port Wine Cellarand guided tasting.

Lunch at a typical and traditional restaurant, for an intimate experience with the region's gastronomy, also in one of the cellars.

Visit WOW – World of Wine, exploring themed museums and immersive experiences. Free time to explore the shops and terrace terraces overlooking the Douro.

Dinner at a typical Matosinhos restaurant specializing in fish and seafood, enjoying a fine wine.

Return to the Hotel Palácio do Freixo, a beacon in Porto's hotel industry along the Douro River.







Day Vinho Verde Region Alvarinho/Monção


Morning departure from Porto towards Monção and visit Quinta da Breijoeira and taste Alvarinho Vinho Verde.

Short visit to Ponte de Lima to enjoy Minho gastronomy, with lunch at a regional restaurant.

After lunch, visit Adega Cooperativa in Ponte de Lima for a Vinho Verde tasting and a brief tour of Ponte de Lima's historic center.

Departure to Amarante with a visit to the historic center.

Check-in at Palácio Casa da Calçada, enjoy dinner at its Michelin-starred restaurant, renowned for its premium regional gastronomy.





Departure towards Régua, capital of the Douro Wine Region and birthplace of Port Wine, a stroll through the historic center and a visit to the Douro Museum to understand the UNESCO-listed landscape.

Lunch at a Port wine estate, Quinta de Santa Eufemia, a visit to the winery, and then a visit to Pinhão, traveling along the EN 222, considered one of the most beautiful roads in the world.

From Pinhão, a visit to the train station, and a one-hour boat ride through the Douro hills.

Arrival at the Quinta da Pacheca Hotel for overnight stay and dinner. This beautiful, palatial, centuries-old manor house is considered one of the most beautiful estates in the Douro.





Day Dão Region Viseu

Departure from the Douro towards the Dão Wine Region (Viseu area) and a short tour of the historic center of Viseu.

Lunch in the city, enjoying typical Beira cuisine: arroz de cabidela (rice with blood), roast veal, or Serra cheese paired with Dão wines.

After lunch, visit the Dão Wine Estate, tasting high-altitude and elegant wines characteristic of the region, with a guided wine tasting.

Return to Porto and end of the 4-day itinerary to the most characteristic Portuguese wine regions in the north: Porto, Minho, Douro, and Dão.

This playbook combines wine, history, gastronomy, and landscape in four intense but balanced days, offering the best of Portugal's wine heritage with authentic and memorable experiences.

Playbook – 4-Day Itinerary through Portugal's Wine Regions

Day 1 – Porto & Gaia: Port Wines and WOW

Morning - Tour of the historic center of Porto and Gaia, with a visit to a Port Wine Cellar and a guided tasting.

Lunch - Typical regional meal in a traditional restaurant inside one of the cellars, with wine pairings.

Afternoon - Visit to WOW – World of Wine, exploring themed museums, immersive experiences, and free time in shops and terraces overlooking the Douro.

Dinner in Matosinhos, at a restaurant specializing in fresh fish and seafood.

Check-in at the Hotel Palácio do Freixo, an iconic Porto hotel on the banks of the Douro.

Day 2 – Minho: Monção, Ponte de Lima & Amarante

Morning - Departure from Porto to Monção.

Visit to Quinta da Brejoeira, with Alvarinho tasting.

Lunch - Short visit to Ponte de Lima, with a regional Minho lunch (arroz de sarrabulho, rojões, or Minho-style cod) accompanied by local Vinho Verde red wine in a ceramic bowl.

Afternoon - Visit to the Ponte de Lima Cooperative Winery, with a Vinho Verde tasting.

Tour of Ponte de Lima's historic center.

Continue to Amarante, with a visit to the historic center.

Check-in no Palácio Casa da Calçada Relais & Châteaux.

Dinner at your Michelin-starred restaurant, a benchmark for premium regional cuisine.

Day 3 – Douro: Régua & Pinhão

Morning - Departure for Peso da Régua, capital of the Douro Wine Region.

Stroll through the historic center and visit the Douro Museum, exploring the UNESCO-listed landscape.

Lunch - Meal at Quinta de Santa Eufémia, with a guided tour of the winery.

Afternoon - Scenic drive along the EN 222, considered one of the most beautiful roads in the world, and visit to the train station with its tile panels.

One-hour boat trip along the Douro River, amidst vineyards and hills.

Dinner and overnight stay at Quinta da Pacheca – Wine House Hotel, a palatial manor house and one of the most emblematic estates in the Douro.

Day 4 – Dão Region & Return to Porto

Morning - Departure from the Douro River towards Viseu.

Brief tour of the historic city center.

Lunch - Typical Beira meal: arroz de cabidela (rice with blood), roast veal, or Serra cheese, paired with Dão wines.

Afternoon - Visit to the Solar do Vinho do Dão (Dão Wine House), with a guided tasting of high-altitude wines, known for their elegance and character.

Return to Porto, concluding the 4-day itinerary through the most iconic wine regions of Northern Portugal: Porto, Minho, Douro, and Dão.
